From the Team Moderator's Desk (Father Rick):

Endowment Fund/Planned Giving – While increasing church support to meet operating and ministerial needs always merits our attention, an aspect that also invites all of our thoughts is what might be termed “planned giving” from our blessings at significant times. As I advance in age and approach the years when I must think about retirement (I have to apply for Medicare before my 65th birthday this September) well before I am actually ready to do so, I cannot help but note that a part of retirement means having to take minimum distributions from funds accumulated to finance in those years what I used to get pay-checks to cover; sometimes these may well exceed our needs and there can be tax advantages for those who choose to make a significant gift(s) to charitable causes – Resurrection Catholic Church and St. Peter Catholic School where a good number of our young families choose to send their children for good Catholic elementary education, to name a few very dear to me and to us; we may also find ourselves to be a bit “over-insured” and be able to assign charitable causes as beneficiaries of such annuities or policies, making a gift that extends us, as it were, after death, into the good works of the church that goes on; we might also remember Resurrection Catholic Church in our wills. If you are in a position as to give these kinds of thoughts some consideration, we would be most truly blessed by your kindness!

Plan Ahead – Masses on Ash Wednesday, February 14, 2018, will be at 12 Noon and 7PM.

Flu Season – A few reminders during this time of year and the outbreak of an unpredictably virulent strain of the flu. First, if you're aware of not feeling well, it might be advisable to refrain briefly from partaking of the common cup to receive the Blood of Christ; second, if you're aware of not feeling well, a polite nod with a smile can be an adequate substitute for the otherwise warm and hearty sharing of the sign of peace to which we are accustomed; third, if you are aware of not feeling well at all, it is no sin to stay home until you are well (missing Mass due to illness needn't be confessed as it was not by any willful, free choice that you got sick); lastly, while it is a good and holy thing to get the St. Blasé blessing against ailments of the throat and all other illnesses, it is also good and important to take good care of yourself, get proper hydration, nutrition, and rest, knowing that an ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure!
