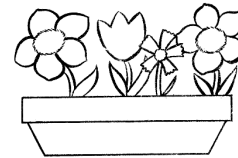

## From the Team Moderator's Desk (Father Rick):

**Have You Ever Been In An Earthquake?** – Earthquakes shake our most basic assumptions: that the ground will stay steady beneath our feet, that the world's current existence is the way it will always be. But when the ground shakes beneath our feet, it rattles bedrock assumptions on which we build our lives. Matthew's Gospel reports, on the first Easter morning, an earthquake rocked the earth, ripped open Jesus' tomb, scaring the Roman soldiers on guard at the tomb, who were "shaken with fear of him and became like dead men." (Matthew 28:4) This is the second earthquake reported by Matthew; the first took place on Good Friday, when the noonday sky turned black and Jesus died. While there is some evidence in the history of antiquity for this particular natural phenomenon occurring at the times Jesus died and rose, the meaning of these is far more significant than their mere occurrence. Extraordinary signs in the sky (recall an unusual star at Jesus' birth), often accompanied by earthquakes, were commonly thought to accompany the birth or death of great persons. Such people make a lasting impact on many lives of beyond regional associations or actual lifetimes; the life and death of Jesus Christ is hereby shown in scripture to have cosmic implications, affecting people both living and dead, far and wide, and all creation as well, making all things new!

**Trustee Election** – In accord with Wisconsin State Statute 187.19 which stipulates that our trustees are to be elected "from and by the congregation," I hereby announce election to be held May 12-13, 2018. John Bingen, our present trustee-treasurer, completes his term of office on June 03, 2018. As he is willing to serve an additional two-year term, I hereby place his name in nomination. Additional candidates are welcome, but must be nominated in writing by ten or more registered parishioners; candidates must be Catholic, registered, practicing parish members, and at least 25 years old. Nomination forms are available at church doors and on-line for anyone interested. Nominations close on April 27, 2018 @ 4:30PM; candidates will be announced at Masses May 05-06; if there is only one candidate, they are then declared elected.

**We Believe in Jesus' Resurrection – Because a.) Jesus predicted it** and He was known, even by those opposed to Him and His teachings, to be without deceit; **b.) The Tomb was found empty.** Although the soldiers claimed that disciples must have come to steal His body, every sensible person in Jerusalem knew it would have been quite impossible for a few frightened men to steal a body from a tomb well-guarded by a detachment of sixteen soldiers; **c.) His disciples at first didn't believe it.** Jesus' repeated apparitions after rising from the dead show that their faith was filled with doubt and needed much proof and these appearances changed them from being filled with fear into confident witnesses at the ready and even glad to suffer anything, even martyrdom, for the sake in His name; **e.) Neither Jewish nor Roman authorities could ever disprove it by presenting His dead Body;** **f.) St. Paul's conversion from persecutor to preacher is not understandable without it** (go see the movie about him that opened last week in the theatres; worthwhile); **g.) The sheer existence, rapid growth and thriving of the Church despite three centuries of violent persecution;** **h.) The Apostles and early believers were neither foolish nor easily duped; they were intelligent people, absolutely sure of what they had seen and heard.**
