## From the Team Moderator's Desk (Father Rick):

**Easter Thoughts** – While people in touch with cultural trends and the secular socialization that surrounds religious events and observances tell me that Christmas is a far more popular holiday than Easter, from a faith point of view this should be challenged at least a bit. At Christmas we celebrate the Nativity of the Lord Jesus, His birthday in the flesh as God with us, among us as one entirely like us in all things but sin. We celebrate with festivity our birthdays and those of others we share life's time and blessings with. While we remember with certain fondness the birthdays of those who have gone before us in death – Dad would have been 95 on March 30 – we do not find ourselves in the same mood or spirit, engaging in the same festivities. That being said, Christmas is full of happy, lively festivity: why? Because Jesus Christ Our Lord, the God Who suffered and died for us, is not dead; He has been raised and death no longer has power over Him – He lives forever! The reason for Christmas being the season it is for us is Easter! St. Paul put it best when he said: "If Christ has not been raised, then empty is our preaching; empty, too, your faith!" Without the Resurrection of Christ, celebrated on Easter and throughout the most-lengthy of liturgical seasons in the Church year, we have no forgiveness of sins and no salvation from death; Easter is the central and crowning truth of our faith as lived by the Christian community since our beginnings. Since every Sunday is considered by the Church to be like a "little Easter," maybe the best way to put Easter in the front of our faith lives is to put participation in Sunday Mass at the front of each and every week, beginning today!

On the day his appointment was confirmed I spoke with him and he is very excited and pleased to be coming to our parishes; he and I will be meeting soon; I will extend your enthusiastic welcome and assure him of your prayers!
