## LIVE THE LITURGY - INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

Today, we are reminded that it is Jesus' suffering, death, resurrection, AND ascension all taken together that make the one event that brings salvation to humanity. Jesus' return to the Father completes the work Jesus came to accomplish and clearly shows us the forgiveness, mercy, and love the Father wishes to bestow upon his children. Faith allows us to savor the mystery of God's design and the hope that awaits us. Today, we are called to look up and see that Jesus ascended to the Father. His mission is completed, and ours is now beginning. Having "looked up," we now have to "look out" into our broken world and deliver the Good News. We now have a new perspective on life and can see things differently: life comes from death, hope from despair, faith from doubt, joy from sadness, and freedom to those who are held bound. It is amazing news indeed! How do we spread the word?

**From the Team Moderator's Desk (Father Rick):**

**Getting to Know Father Jonathon** – The following appeared in the worship aid for the Mass of Ordination: *“Being in the seminary has been a great experience learning how to love Jesus, love His people, and love His Church. I have had so much joy in going deeper into the Sacred Heart of Jesus and bringing His love to those around me. I’m really excited about being that mediator for other people – the people of God.”* His home parish was St. John the Baptist in Paris, WI (near Union Grove); his assignment as shared associate with us begins June 18; his intercessor is St. John the Beloved.

**Why Celebrate the Ascension This Sunday** – Rather than on the previously traditional Thursday? Try understanding this through a common metaphor for this time of year – **moving!** While a good number of us have been rooted in the area for years, generations, many have moved here from another city, state or country. This experience can be most difficult for families, especially those with children. The father of a boy named Andrew got a new job and the family was moving to a new city. Since it was so close to end of the school year, it was decided that it would be far better if Andrew stayed behind to finish the school year. It was hard for him to be left behind, but his father told him that they would go ahead and find a place for them to live and make sure it was ready when it was time for him to join them. He told Andrew that there was nothing to worry about because he would be staying with some very good friends who would look after him and make sure that he had everything he needed. During the time Andrew was separated from his parents, his parents called to talk with him on the phone every day. They told him about his new home and about how much he was going to like it. It helped Andrew a lot to talk with them and to know that they would come for him soon and he would join them in his new home. Does this sound at least a little bit like what Jesus did for us? Before He returned home to heaven to be with His Father, He said that He was going to prepare a place for us and then He promised to come back to take us with Him so that we could be together in our new home. When Jesus ascended, He didn't leave us alone. He promised to give us the Holy Spirit to watch over us, to teach us and remind us of all He had told us. Not only that, we also can talk with Jesus daily in prayer. Making the mystery of the Lord's Ascension a part of our weekend celebrations helps us sense just how much a part of Easter the Lord's Ascension really is!
